### **VISION:**

Westminster is supported by an inclusive multimodal transportation network that provides safe and well-connected transportation and mobility choices to connect people to local and regional destinations.

## **GOALS:**

The Transportation & Mobility Plan goals will help guide the development of policies, recommendations, and implementation measures of success. The goals will also inform the prioritization of transportation projects and resources. The goals were developed using key components from existing transportation plans, Westminster's current Strategic Plan, community and staff input received to-date, and transportation industry best practices.



#### CONNECT

Develop a comprehensive multimodal transportation network that includes convenient, safe, and accessible transportation options for all and integrates land use.



#### THDIVE

Support the community's economic resilience, environment, public health, and quality of life.



#### **PROTECT**

Reduce traffic-related deaths and injuries by improving the safety and comfort for all modes of transportation.



#### **MAINTAIN**

Maintain the City's transportation assets and optimize the use of the transportation network.



#### **COLLABORATE**

Identify and utilize opportunities to coordinate projects and funding with local, regional, state, and private partners.



#### **INNOVATE**

Apply creative, sustainable, and cost-effective solutions to address transportation and mobility needs.



#### **FUND**

Pursue revenue resources to build, maintain, and operate new and existing transportation infrastructure and services.



#### WHAT IS A MULTIMODAL TRANSPORTATION NETWORK?

A multimodal transportation network includes all the ways people move around their community: walking, biking, using a wheelchair, riding the bus or train, driving, or carpooling. It also includes new transportation modes like electric scooters and ride-hailing, as well as future technologies. It is important that modes of transportation within the network are well-connected, accessible, and interact safely. The network not only includes infrastructure and vehicles, but is also supported by education, safety, and maintenance programs.
