

### TERMS AND DEFINITIONS



AS CITY PLANNERS, WE NEED TO KNOW A LOT OF WORDS. BELOW ARE JUST A FEW FOR YOU TO BE AWARE OF:

CIRCULATION - A ROAD, SIDEWALK, BIKE PATH, HIKING TRAIL; A PATHWAY DESIGNED FOR TRAVEL.

CITY COUNCIL - A GROUP OF CITIZENS ELECTED BY OTHER CITIZENS TO MAKE NECESSARY DECISIONS FOR THE PROGRESS AND LEADERSHIP OF A COMMUNITY.

**DEVELOPMENT** - A PLACE WHERE THERE ARE BUILDINGS, PARKING, CIRCULATION, AND LAND-SCAPING.

**DRAINAGE** - A PATHWAY OR COLLECTION AREA FOR RAINWATER AND MELTING SNOW.

LAND USE - LAND CATEGORIES WHICH ALLOW CERTAIN USES LIKE HOUSES, RESTAURANTS, OFFICES, ETC.

LANDSCAPING - GRASS, TREES, ROCKS, SHRUBS, THAT ARE PLACED AROUND BUILDINGS OR PARKING LOTS.

MATERIALS - A PRODUCT USED FOR COVERING A BUILDING; FOR INSTANCE, BRICK AND STONE ARE OFTEN USED AS BUILDING MATERIALS.

MAYOR - A CITIZEN WHO IS ELECTED TO SPEAK FOR THE COMMUNITY IN PUBLIC SITUATIONS OR EVENTS.

MIXED USE - MIXING HOUSING, RESTAURANTS, AND SHOPPING IN ONE DEVELOPMENT.


PARKS/OPEN SPACE - GREENSPACES WHERE THE PUBLIC CAN PLAY OR ENJOY A NATURAL ENVIRONMENT.

**PARKING LOT** - AN AREA WHERE VISITORS, CAN PARK THEIR CARS WHILE THEY ARE VISITING A PLACE OR BUILDING.


**SIGN** - A TOOL USED FOR ADVERTISING A BUSINESS OR IDENTIFYING A BUILDING.


**ZONING** - THE LOCATION BOUNDARY, AND RULES, THAT DETERMINE WHICH LAND USES CAN GO WHERE.











A SITE PLAN LOOKS FLAT AND MAKES YOU FEEL LIKE YOU ARE FLYING ABOVE...







THE SEPARATION BETWEEN BUILDINGS IS A "SETBACK"...




SETBACKS ARE IMPORTANT TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF FIRE...

• TREES ARE FOUND ALL AROUND THE PROPERTY. THEY PROVIDE GOOD SHADE BUT SHOULD NOT BE LOCATED TOO CLOSE TO THE HOUSE SO THE ROOTS DON'T DAMAGE THE FOUNDATION.
